



Bosch is planning to invest \$130 million to expand its power tools accessories manufacturing capabilities in Lincoln County. That announcement was preceded by the state's economic investment committee approving incentives for the project at a meeting this morning. The expansion is expected to create 404 jobs, committee members said when outlining the project. The new positions include minimum average annual wages of \$53,204, which is above the county average of \$49,332.

"We aim to provide local-for-local solutions to support our businesses and the expansion for Power Tools in Lincolnton is further evidence of our commitment to develop local manufacturing here in the region," said **Mike Mansuetti**, president of Bosch in North America.






Captron, a German electronics manufacturer, has relocated its U.S. headquarters, sales, and service operations to Lancaster County.
